## Vancouver Gateway Program

As traffic problems continue to mount in Vancouver, the Province of British Columbia is considering an ambitious program of transportation improvements. The Gateway Program is a group of potential highway projects along the Fraser River corridor, regarded as the gateway to Greater Vancouver, other parts of Canada, and international markets.
